Summary:

The Coaching Co-ordinator (Juniors) is responsible for overseeing the training, development and management of the club's coaches of junior teams.

Responsible to:

The Coaches Co-ordinator (Juniors) is directly responsible to the Coaches co-ordinator, the committee and members of the South Upwey Netball Club.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Manage junior player enquiries, onboarding and development for the club in accordance with executive committee consultation.
- Support junior player training sessions in partnership with the team coaches and coaches coordinator, aligned with the skills development plan outlined by the coaches coordinator.
- Junior player development planning.
- Promote fundraising events with member base.
- Assist with the planning and conduct of junior player social events.
- Liaise with parents on matters relating to the club, teams and MDNA competition, including social events.
- Ensure matters relating to all players, their families and coaches uphold the conditions and expectations within the club's code of conduct and uphold Child Safety standards.
- Identify opportunities to recruit new players and promote the club.
- Maintain communication channels with junior players and their parents through messaging and social media groups.
- Assisting with Netball Connect and associated systems for team/game management and scoring, including player registration & uniform purchasing
- Attend at least one MDNA Delegate meeting.

Knowledge and Skills Required

- Knowledge of the South Upwey Netball Club Constitution and how the club operates
- A strong understanding of netball and association rules and procedures.
- Can communicate effectively
- Enthusiasm and positivity
- Commitment to the well-being and participation of players in a safe and inclusive community sports setting.
